

## **CLARIFICATIONS REGARDING CHANGE OVER FROM QMP TO PEXO SYSTEM**

There have been numerous enquiries, arising out of a lack of clarity, concerning the news update elaborating the phased changeover from the current QMP Examination System to the new PEXO system.

Please note the following clarifications:

- In order to switch over to the new system, there will be **no new examinees**\*\*\* accepted for writing an examination during July 2018. \*\*\* **A New Examinee** is anyone writing an examination for the first time in either the CPL or ATPL set of subjects. (An examinee writing a first CPL examination will be considered a new examinee. Similarly, an examinee writing a first ATPL examination will also be a new examinee. Bookings for writing in Aug 2018 by such individuals, however, may be made.
- General Radiotelephony, IR (Operational Procedures), and Cabin Crew examinations applicants may, however, continue to book and write during July 2018.
- CPL or ATPL examinees, who have started writing examinations in their respective set of subjects, prior to 30 Jun 2018, may continue writing during July 2018.
- Also please note that this change of examination system DOES NOT alter, modify or deviate from the current contents and methodology of conducting examinations.
