Minister of Transport, Honourable Dipuo Peters, to officiate over the unveiling of the Moiletsoane Computer Centre.

As part of its Corporate Social Responsibility programme, the South African Civil Aviation Authority adopted Moiletsoane Primary School in 2011 during the International Nelson Mandela Day. The school is situated in a village by the same name in the North West Province.

The relationship with the school started off when SACAA staff and management painted the classrooms, provided furniture for the staff room and established a vegetable garden. Blankets were also donated to the 150 orphans at the school. Subsequent projects with the school included involving the children from this school and the neighbouring Secondary school (Mmamogwai Secondary School) in the SACAA's annual Take a Girl Child to Work days and the Tracker Man in the Making initiatives.

A recent needs analysis indicated that a computer laboratory was required. The SACAA once again participated by providing the community and school with a fully functional computer lab.
