CESSNA 172 CRASH IN PORT ALFRED

A Cessna 172 flying from Durban to Port Alfred crashed 3km north-west of the airfield in Port Alfred. The aircraft was carrying 3 German passengers. Even though the aircraft was badly damaged no injuries were reported from this accident. The pilot said that he got lost and later experienced an engine failure. The CAA is investigating this incident.
