SAFETY

BARBERTON AIRFIELD (FABR) SAFETY WARNING

- ☛ Indicate changes
 - ☛ This AIC replaces AIC 21-2 dated 07-05-11 in total.
1. The Barberton Airfield is occasionally used as a Filming Location. Low level fixed wing and helicopter operations take place within a 5nm radius of the airfield and often communicate on private frequencies so as not to congest frequency 124.8 MHz.
 2. Occasional use of Explosives and High Power Lasers for Special Effects Purposes for Stunts, Film & TV productions as well as Aerial Pyrotechnics up to a height of approximately 1500ft agl.
 3. The above activities can take place any time of the day or night.
 4. SAPS approved explosives blast sites, aerial pyrotechnic launch sites and explosives magazines are located on the property. Co-ordinates: S25°43'051 E030°58'515
 5. Pilots are requested to call or announce their intentions on frequency 124.8 MHz if intending to land, operate in the vicinity of or overhead Barberton Airfield.
