AIRCREW PILOTS

CURTAILMENT OF PRIVILEGES OF PILOT LICENCE HOLDERS AGED 60 YEARS OR MORE

A Indicates changes

A1. This AIC replaces AIC 31-1-1 dated 95-10-15.

The South African Civil Aviation Authority has filed a difference to paragraph 2.1.10 to Annex 1 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, International Standards and Practices, Personnel Licensing in accordance with the requirements of Article 38 to the Convention on International Civil Aviation, Doc. 7300/5 as hereunder:

A "The South African Civil Aviation Authority shall not permit the holder of a pilots licence, which it has issued, who has attained the age of 60 years, to act as pilot-in-command or co-pilot, as appropriate, of an aircraft engaged in scheduled international air services or non-scheduled international transport operations for remuneration or hire except:

1.) As a member of a multi-pilot crew and provided that:

A 2.) such holder is the only pilot in the flight crew who has attained age 60; and

3.) the aircraft is fitted with dual controls."

Such pilots shall not act as pilot of an aircraft engaged in scheduled/nonscheduled international air service operations after attaining 65 years of age.
