AUTHORISATION FOR MICROLIGHT FLIGHT INSTRUCTORS TO GIVE FLYING INSTRUCTION FOR REMUNERATION

Regulation 2.24 A of the Air Navigation Regulations, 1976, promulgated in terms of section 22 (1) of the Aviation Act, 1962 (Act No 74 of 1962), relates to micro light aeroplane pilots. A pilot-in-command of a micro light aeroplane is prohibited from operating for remuneration if his or her activities fall within the ambit of paragraphs (a), (c), (d) or (e) of the mentioned regulation.

It is thus permissible for micro light pilots with instructor ratings to give instruction for remuneration. However, such instruction may only be provided if Part 141 of the Civil Aviation Regulations, 1997, relating to aviation training organisations is complied with. This does not include 'flipping' as prescribed in Part 96 of the Regulations.
