PPL EXAMINATION FEES

During a recent Industry Liaison Forum (ILF) held at the offices of the CAA, a request was made by the ILF for the CAA to clarify some issues around the charging of examination fees at the CAA approved examination centres.

The ILF requested that a notice be published on the CAA website in this regard and that all approved examination centres prominently display the notice at their centres as well as that the contents are brought to the attention of their clients.

METHOD OF IMPLEMENTATION

In terms of the Civil Aviation Regulations, 1997, Regulation 187.00.7(e)(i) the CAA requires an examination fee of R220.00 for an on-line examination.

In the case of PPL examinations, the CAA currently only recovers a R220 fee for 14 attempts. This is also the fee charged by the CAA at its Midrand Examination Centre.

The CAA does not control the examination fees charged by the approved examination centres, as it has been determined that the CAA will not regulate the fees that industry charges its clients for services, as their fees are determined by market forces in the industry..

FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

Please take note that a change proposal has been submitted to amend the fees charged in terms of Part 187 and on a cost recovery basis, when implemented, the CAA will recover a proposed fee of R70.00 per PPL examination subject written at all approved examination centres.
